

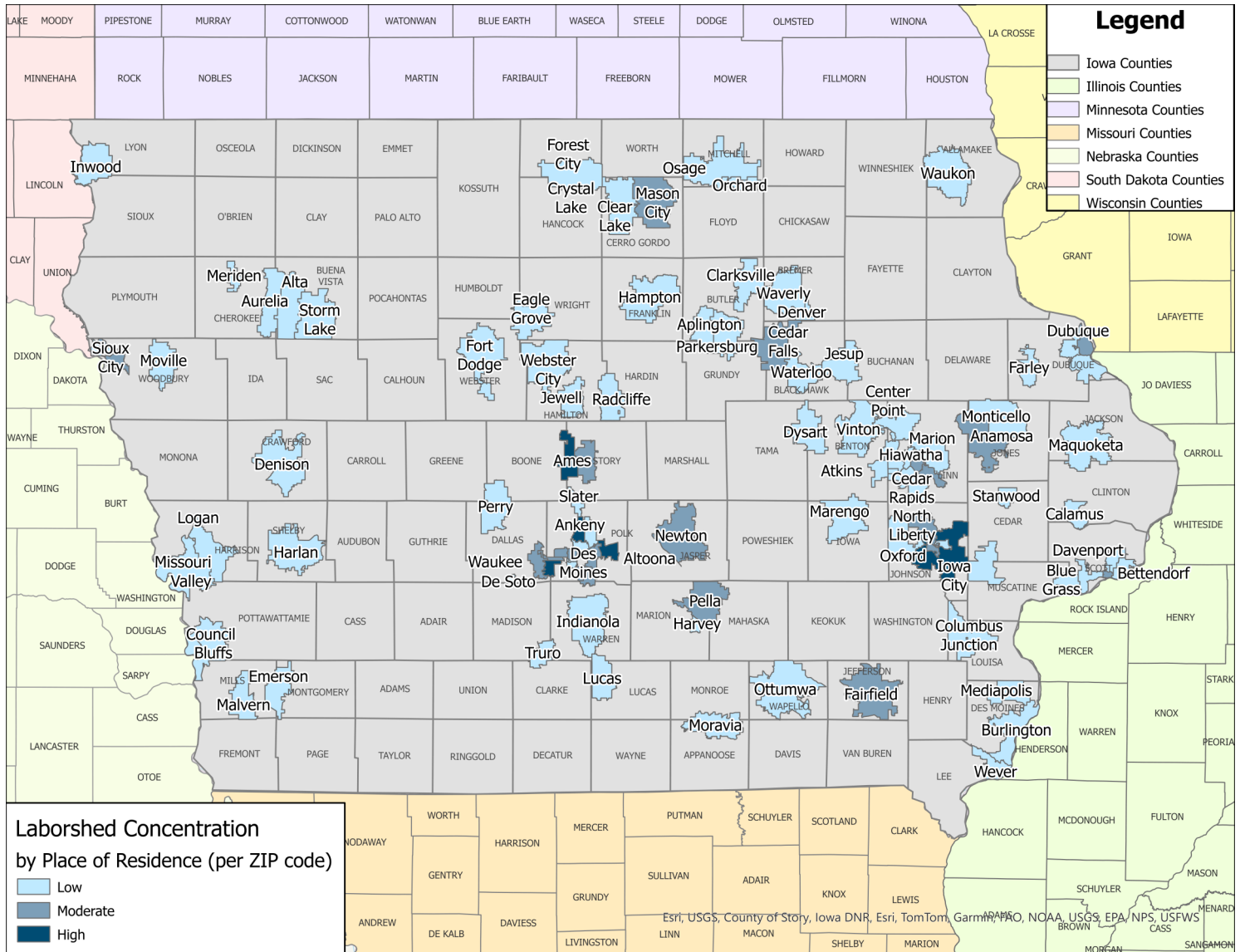

## CONCENTRATION OF RESPONDENTS WITHIN THE LABORSHED AREA WITH TRANSFERABLE EXPERIENCE/SKILLS BY PLACE OF RESIDENCE



Workers who have transferable experience/skills in the industry are currently commuting an average of 14 miles one way for work. Those who are likely to change/accept employment are willing to commute an average of 27 miles one way for the right employment opportunity.

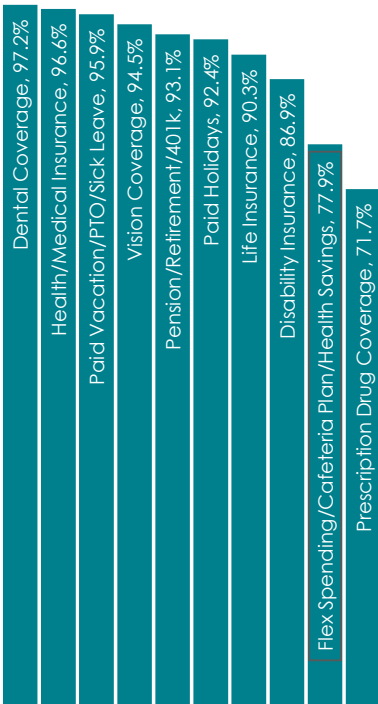

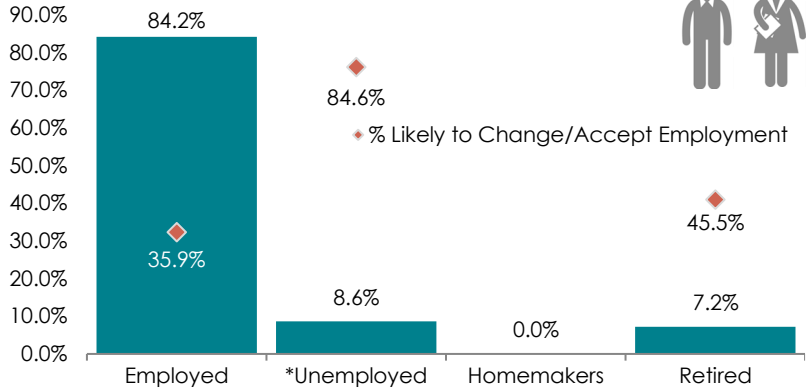

### ESTIMATED TOTAL BY EMPLOYMENT STATUS (PERCENTAGE):



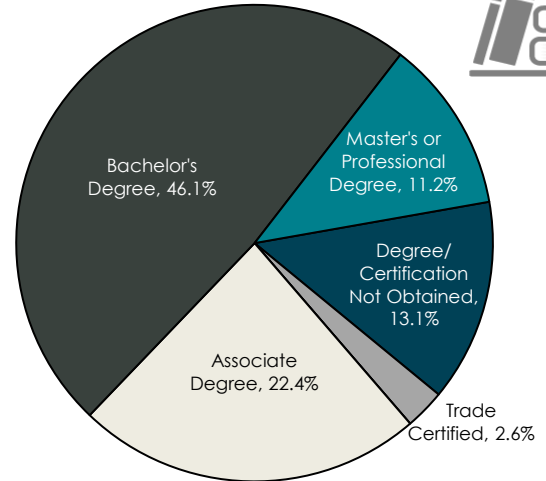
