Additional Resources at an IowaWORKS Center

Title 1 Adult and Dislocated Worker (WIOA) - Provide retraining services for qualifying individuals which can include educational and on-the-job training. Provide case-managed support services as needed.

Title 1 Youth - Provide training and support services for qualifying youth ages 14-24.

Vocational Rehabilitation/ Department For The Blind - Provides services to eligible individuals with disabilities to help them reach a successful employment outcome. Provides individualized plans focusing on a diverse range of employment opportunities.

Ticket to WORK - Assist individuals who receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and/or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) with navigating their benefits. Provides eligible individuals with benefit planning as well as employment and career services.

Title II Adult Basic Education and English Learning - Provides basic skills instruction in math, reading, writing, English language instruction, and HiSET preparation.

Business Engagement Team— Connecting job seekers with recruiting businesses

Veteran Career Planner - Assist eligible veterans and spouses with employment and provide individualized career services, pre-vocational services, and coordinate supportive services.

Migrant Seasonal Farmworkers - Migrant and Seasonal Farm Worker (MSFW) outreach program is focused on educating and assisting farm workers and agricultural employers.

PROMISE JOBS - Provides employment and training opportunities to lowans who receive Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) (In Iowa - Family Investment Program) funds.

Reemployment Services and Eligibility Assessments (RESEA) - Provides intensive one on one assistance to selected unemployment claimants while receiving unemployment benefits.
