BREAKOUT OF THE EMPLOYED BY INDUSTRY (ESTIMATED TOTAL)

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



UNEMPLOYED: LIKELY TO ACCEPT



The Laborshed survey collects information regarding the **out commute** for an employment center.

The out commute

for Clarinda is estimated at 21.2 percent approximately 565 people living in Clarinda work in other communities.

Most of those who are out commuting are working in Shenandoah, IA, Maryville, MO, and Red Oak, IA.

Over one-fifth (22.7%) of out commuters are likely to change employment (approximately 128 people).

UNDEREMPLOYMENT

The underemployed are working fewer than 35 hours per week but desire more hours (**inadequate hours**); in positions that do not meet their skill or education level, or have worked for higher wages at previous employment (**mismatch of skills**); or are earning wages equal to or less than the national poverty level and work 35 or more hours per week (**low income**).
