









UNDEREMPLOYMENT

The underemployed are working fewer than 35 hours per week but desire more hours (inadequate hours); in positions that do not meet their skill or education level, or have worked for higher wages at previous employment (mismatch of skills); or are earning wages equal to or less than the national poverty level and work 35 or more hours per week (low income).
