







2023 Employment Benefit Analysis for the Iowa Plains Local Workforce Development Area

lowa Workforce Development (IWD) conducted the seventh Workforce Needs Assessment Survey during the fall of 2022 through the spring of 2023. Within this survey, data regarding the benefits employers offer their employees is collected. Surveyed employers are asked: if benefits are offered, who are benefits offered to, which benefits are offered, and the cost of benefits—among other questions.

In October of 2022, 25,160 employers operating 39,254 locations in the State of Iowa were contacted and asked to participate in the survey. In the Iowa Plains LWDA, 9,460 locations were contacted. By the end of the survey period (March 2023), IWD received 1,242 responses from employers in the Iowa Plains LWDA, for a response rate of 13.1% (by locations contacted).












