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Grant Overview

Award and Funding

- The purpose of the Iowa Apprenticeship Act (84E) grant is to provide financial
 assistance to sponsors who conduct and maintain an apprenticeship program
 that has been registered and meets Iowa Office of Apprentice and Department of
 Labor specific requirement standards. Funds awarded may only be used to help
 cover the cost of conducting and maintaining an apprenticeship training program
 with in-person classroom training.
- The State of Iowa has appropriated \$3,000,000 for FY2025 to support the growth of registered apprenticeship programs. This is a reimbursement grant; the expenses that will be reimbursed are those that directly serve the apprentice and the apprenticeship program. Documentation of each expense will be required.



Eligibility

Eligibility to Apply

- Applicants must have an lowa-based apprenticeship program registered in the RAPIDS system for apprentices employed at lowa worksites.
- Applicants must have at least one apprentice with a status of "Registered" in the RAPIDS system on December 31, 2024.
- Applicants must provide proof of a minimum of 100 in-person related training instruction hours during the 2024 calendar year, per apprentice, to qualify for funding.
- Only registered apprentices who reside in lowa are eligible to be included in a sponsor's application for funding.
- A qualified registered apprentice that may be included in the applicant's total apprentice count is defined as an active registered apprentice on December 31, 2024, or an apprentice that completed their registered apprenticeship program during the 2024 calendar year.



Eligibility to Apply, continued


- Applicants must comply with all applicable provisions of state and federal laws pertaining to nondiscrimination, sexual harassment, and equal employment opportunity.
- Applicants receiving 84F funding during the same fiscal year will not be eligible for 84E funds.
- Applicants must apply through lowaGrants.gov utilizing the approved and provided forms.



Reimbursement

Reimbursement Vs. Eligibility Period

- An eligible Sponsor must have had at least one apprentice in their program as of December 31, 2024
- A sponsor can submit reimbursement for expenses accumulated between July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2027, and while there was an active apprentice





Reimbursable Expenses

- □ Reimbursement of wages for the registered apprentice(s) while participating in On-the-Job Learning
 (OJL)
- □ Reimbursement of the salary/wages for a Registered Apprenticeship Coordinator or a Program Manager (while there is at least one registered apprentice participating).
- ☐ Related Instruction tuition and associated fees for active and registered apprentices
- ☐ Related Instruction materials (e.g., textbooks, curriculum, etc.) for active and registered apprentices
- ☐ Related Instruction instructor salaries (while there is at least one registered apprentice participating)
- ☐ Registered Apprenticeship single purchase of equipment/supplies not exceeding \$5,000.
 - Items such as, but not limited to:
 - Tools
 - Protective apparel or materials (e.g. PPE, gloves, uniforms)
 - Laptops/Computers
- ☐ In-State travel lodging expenses (must follow 2025 DAS reimbursement policies)
- ☐ In-State Conference fees for a registered apprentice

What is required in the application?

General Information:


- Program Contact Name
- Program E-Mail Address
- Legal Organization Name (as shown on your W-9)
- Business Address (No P.O Box)
- RAPIDS Program #
- Agreement to fulfilling Environmental & Worker Safety Affidavit
- Agreement of Employed at Iowa Work Site
- Agreement of Use of Iowa Apprenticeship Training Grant

Grant specific Information:

- Total number of qualified registered apprentices (apprentices included in the applicant's total apprentice count are defined as an active or completed apprentice during the most recent training year)
- Iowa residency for all apprentices verified via the RAPIDS database system.
- Proof of a minimum of 100 in-person related training hours per registered apprentice claimed.
- Proof of active Registered Apprenticeship program in good standing with the Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship.
