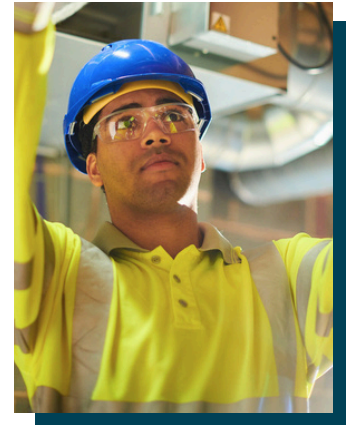


SUPPORTING REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIPS

The Iowa Registered Apprenticeship Development Program (84F) provides annual funding to support the growth of new Registered Apprenticeship programs, particularly programs that feature high-demand occupations. These competitive grants are available annually for RA programs that create a new program with an eligible high-demand occupation or add an eligible high-demand occupation to their existing program.
