# 2021 ANNUAL PROFILE CENTRAL IOWA LWDA IOWA WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

**Executive Summary** 


As of 2020, the Central Iowa LWDA's largest private industry was Manufacturing, representing 20.6 percent (65,970) of the region's total covered employment of 429,303. The region's total employment decreased by 4.6 percent since 2019, while the average annual wage increased by 8.4 percent to \$60,595 for all industries. While the majority of industries in the region recorded losses in employment, Ag/Natural Resources & Mining, Construction, Transportation & Utilities and Finance, Insurance, and Real Estate all had increases in employment, with Transportation & Utilities having the largest increase in employment with 1.6 percent in 2020. The largest loss in employment was posted in the Leisure & Hospitality industry with 21.2 percent, during 2020

The Central Iowa LWDA average weekly wage for all industries was \$1,165 for 2020. This was an increase of 8.4 percent since 2019. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector industry was in Finance, Insurance, Real Estate averaging \$1,808. Between 2019 and 2020, the Professional & Business Services sector reported the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 8.9




#### Size of Firm




#### **Labor Force 2020**


# Annual 2020 UI Benefits
