Executive Summary


As of 2020, the Northeast Iowa LWDA's largest private industry was Manufacturing, representing 19.0 percent (45,745) of the region's total covered employment of 241,160. The region's total employment decreased by 5.1 percent since 2019, while the average annual wage increased by 6.5 percent to \$47,899 for all industries. While the majority of industries in the region recorded losses in employment, Transportation was the only to increase by 3.2 percent in 2020. The largest loss in employment was posted in the Leisure & Hospitality industry with 15.7 percent, during 2020.

The Northeast Iowa LWDA average weekly wage for all industries was \$921 for 2020. This was an increase of 6.5 percent since 2019. The highest average weekly wage for a private sector industry was in Finance, Insurance, Real Estate averaging \$1,257. Between 2019 and 2020, the Information sector reported the largest percentage increase in average weekly wage of 15.4 percent.

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



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
Size of Firm





Unemployment averaged 5.4 percent in Northeast lowa LWDA for 2020. The region's jobless rate translated into 14,900 unemployed persons.

The 2020 unemployment rate for Northeast Iowa LWDA was higher than the statewide average of 5.3 percent.

Lyon County reported the lowest jobless rate in the state in 2020 at 2.5 percent.

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
Annual 2020 UI Benefits
