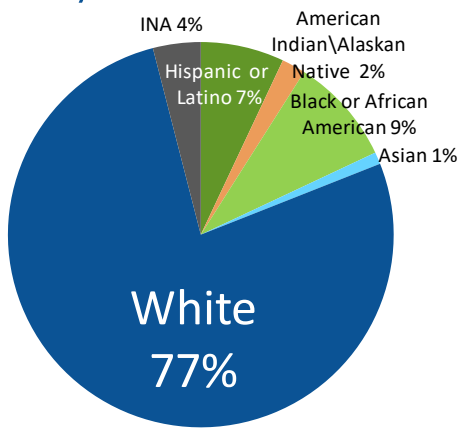


51% of claimants were **MALE**

48% of claimants were **FEMALE**

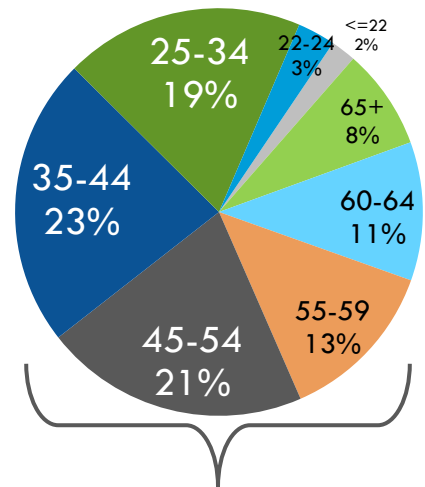

77% of all claimants were white followed by 9% Black or African American.

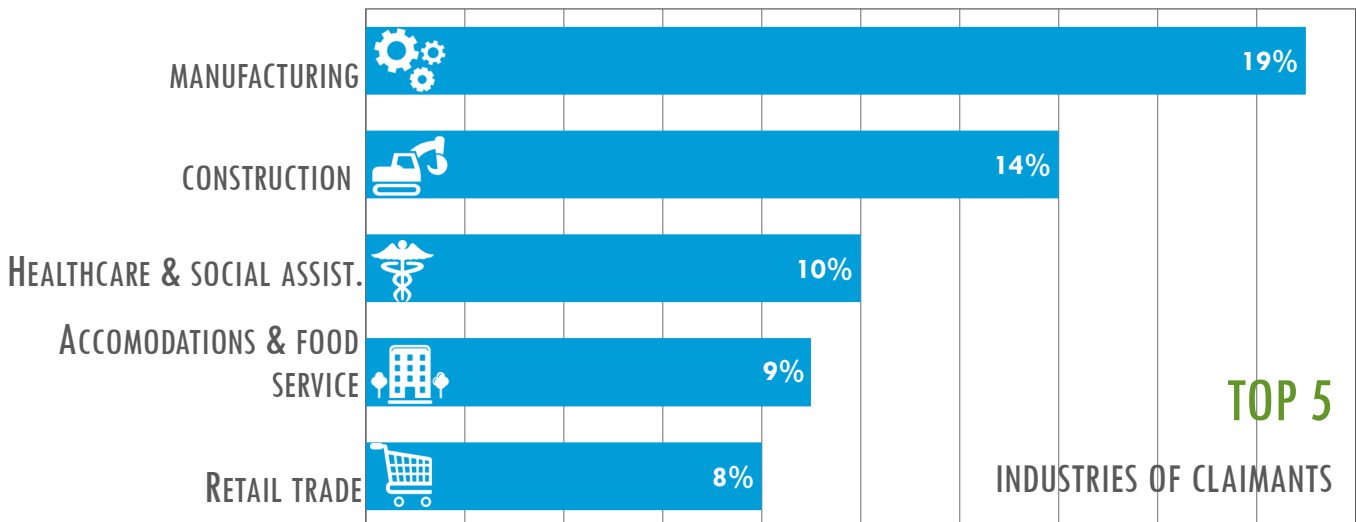
AGE

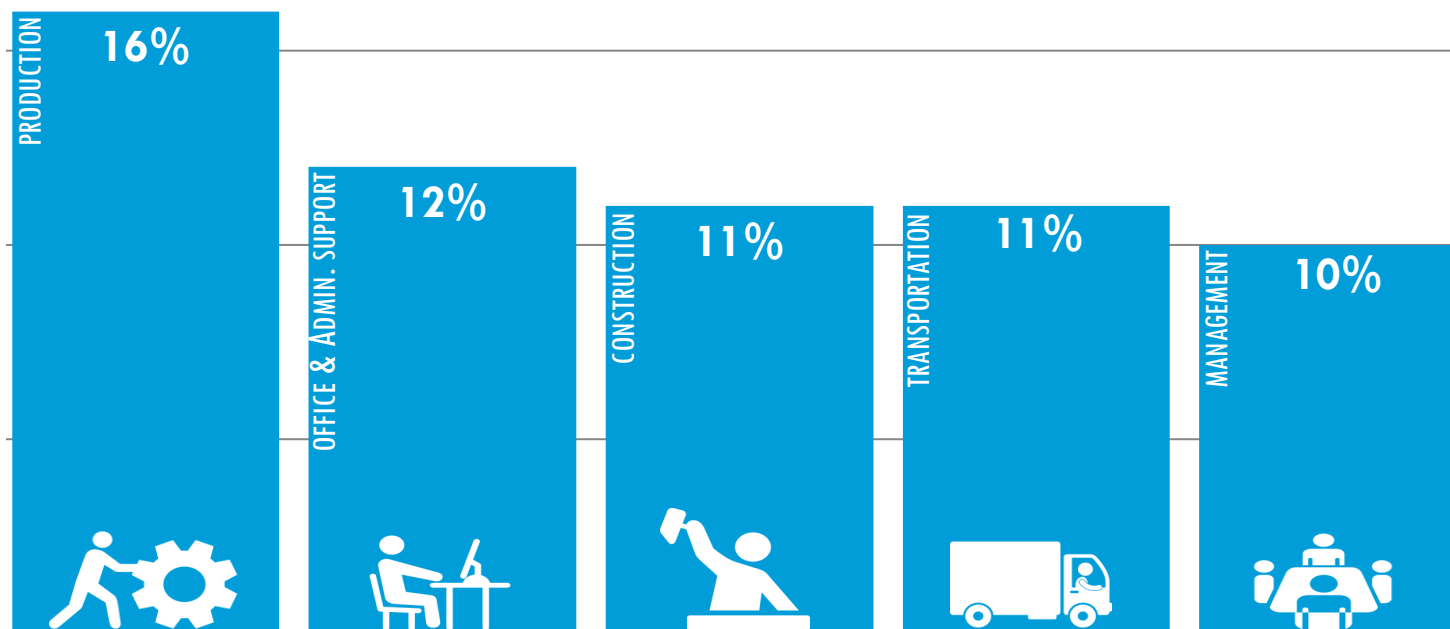

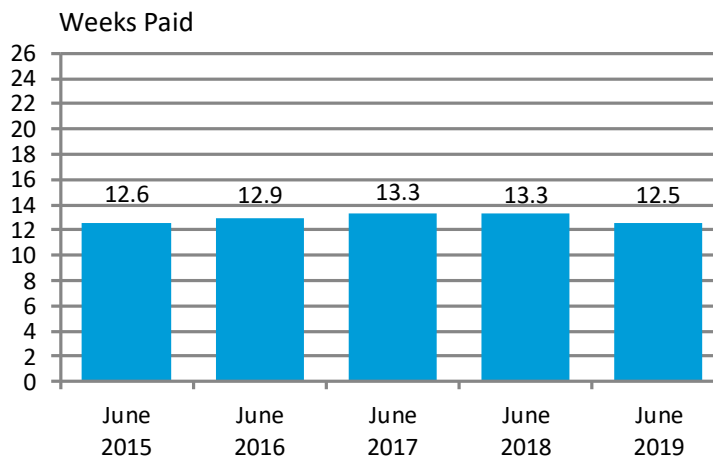
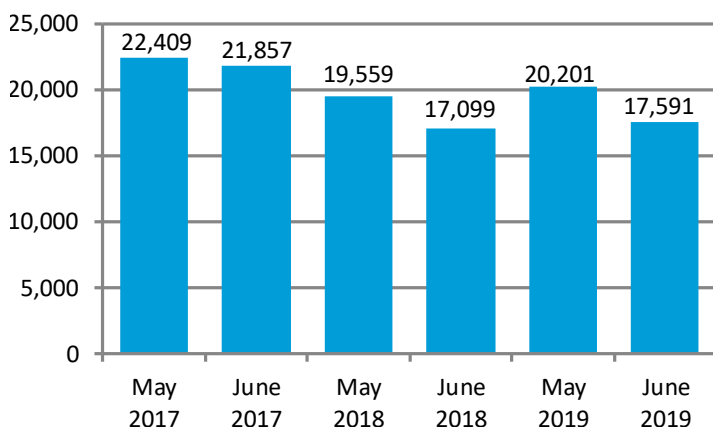
OCCUPATION

- Recipients represent the number of persons receiving at least one UI benefit payment during the month.
- The number of UI recipients decreased to 17,591 in June 2019 from 20,201 in May 2019 as construction layoffs decreased.

- The maximum duration of UI benefits for most UI claimants is 26 weeks.
- The duration of benefits for June 2019 remained at 12.5 weeks. The duration of benefits was 13.3 weeks in June 2018.

These characteristics do not necessarily reflect job leavers, new entrants, reentrants, and benefit exhaustees. According to the UI Data Summary publication, about 40% of unemployed persons in Iowa received UI benefits.
