









OCCUPATIONAL CATEGORIES OF CLAIMANTS

- Recipients represent the number of persons receiving at least one UI benefit payment during the month.
- The number of UI recipients increased in November as season layoffs in Construction continue.
- The maximum duration of UI benefits for most UI claimants is 26 weeks.
- The duration of UI benefits decreased to 12.8 weeks for November from 12.9 weeks in October. The duration of UI benefits was at 13.4 weeks in November of 2017.

These characteristics do not necessarily reflect job leavers, new entrants, reentrants, and benefit exhaustees. According to the UI Data Summary publication, about 40% of unemployed persons in Iowa received UI benefits.
